200 Chain Breakers

Chain (chān), noun

1. *Chain*: a restraining or confining agent or force
2. *Chain of events*: concept that many contributing factors lead to an outcome
3. *Chain of people*: those who are closely linked or connected

One of the most oppressive chains of restraint that exists today in the UK is sexual exploitation. Most of the women, men and children working in prostitution are drawn into it by a chain of events - poverty, homelessness, drug dependency, and a lack of opportunities. The results are lives constrained, exploited, and abused. But we believe in life beyond prostitution. **We want to break the chains of sexual exploitation by creating a positive chain: a chain of people who will stand together to make a difference.**

Beyond the Streets has been working to stop sexual exploitation for more than a decade and supports a network of over 50 grassroots projects. With an estimated 80,000 people involved in prostitution in the UK¹, our desire is to see these unjust chains broken. **We want to see more people equipped, more resources, and more time devoted to ending sexual exploitation.**
